



It was 1171 and Henry II, as had so many before him, proclaimed that Dublin was under his rule. The Normans, following Henry's wishes, began "developing" Dublin into a modern city. One eventual "development" was the building of what stands today as Dublin's oldest hotel and pub, THE BRAZEN HEAD. Built in 1198 precisely 800 years before its Omaha namesake, the establishment stood, and stands today, at the head of the river Liffey. It was there that Norman soldiers warmed their hands against the chilled night air while guarding the gate to the city. The barrels of fire they used were called "brazers".

Thus THE BRAZEN HEAD, place of the Brazers, at the head of the river. For centuries, THE BRAZEN HEAD on Dublin's Bridge Street served as a safe haven for Irish revolutionaries. The statue of a famous, or infamous, revolutionary, Robert Emmet, stands guard in our smoke room, much as the Norman soldiers guarded the city of Dublin 800 years ago.

The HARP is the oldest official symbol of Ireland. It is the same small, portable harp, often carried by Celtic minstrels. Though not as well-known as the shamrock, the harp is one of the most widely used icons, appearing on Irish coins, numerous flags, state seals, uniforms, and official documents. However, the harp has become most associated with the Guinness Brewery, who adopted the harp as its trademark in 1862.

The #1 attraction in Ireland has to be Blarney Castle, home of the legendary BLARNEY STONE. Legend says that if you kiss the stone, lodged high up in the main castle wall, by hanging upside down and backwards from the battlements, you'll either receive the gift of great eloquence or be granted a single wish. Elizabeth the First is credited with naming the stone. Upon hearing of its supposed "magical" properties, she was recorded to have said, "This is all Blarney." The name stuck, and a new word was added to the English language.

The SHAMROCK is surely the most identifiable symbol of Ireland. "Shamrock" comes from the Gaelic, SEAMROG, a word that refers to the plant's three leaves. Legend has it that during a religious debate with the Druid priests, St. Patrick plucked a shamrock to demonstrate the mystery of the Christian Trinity - three leaves held together by a single stem. Whether or not the story is true, the shamrock is regarded as the national plant of Ireland and always worn on St. Patrick's Day.
